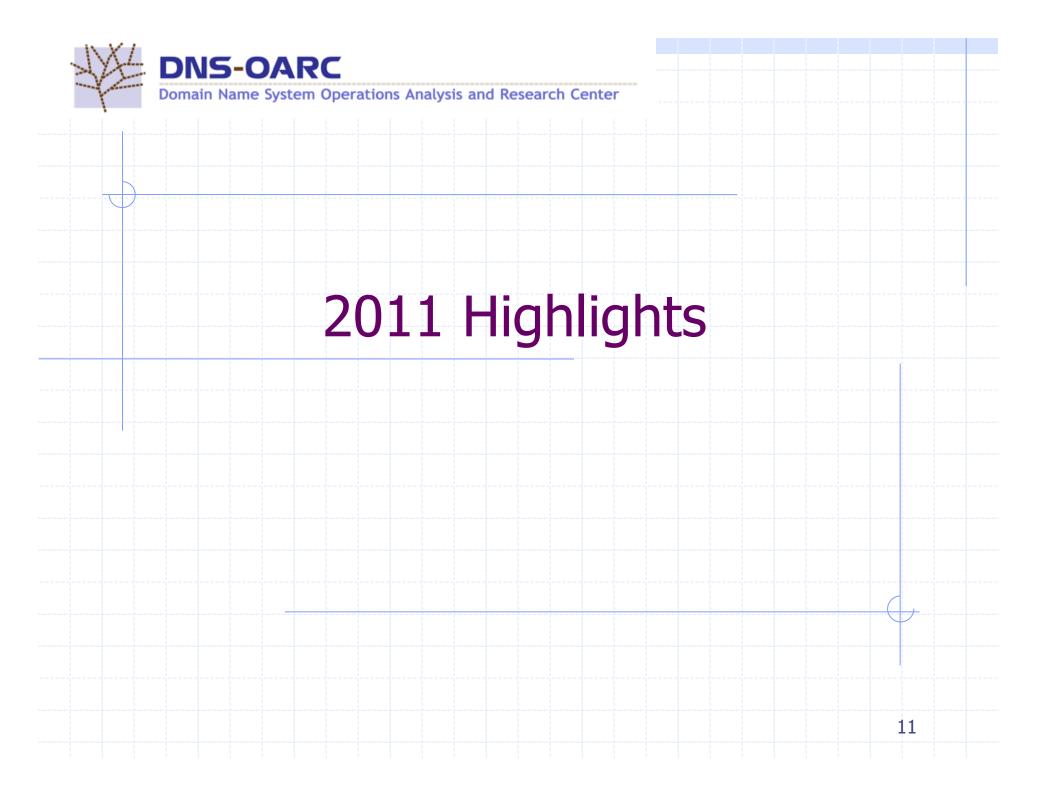

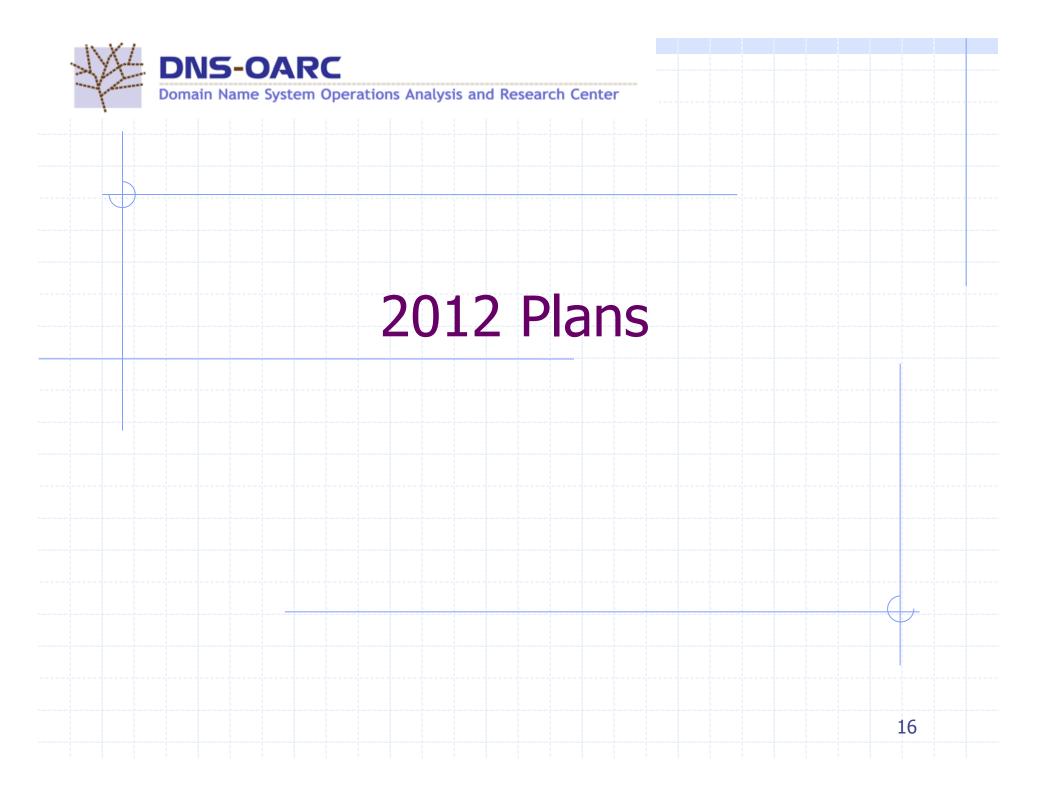


DITL - IPV6 Day 2011
