AGM Process

- Each member representative should have signed in, and received:
 - colored voting card please hold up per resolution for one of yes/no/abstain vote
 - voting paper please mark your preferred candidates from 1 to up to 7 in decreasing preference, and hand in to William
- Board results will be announced after software vote-count, which may be via e-mail after meeting close

Recent Board Changes

- OARC Board positions belong to Member organizations, not the elected individuals
- This has lately led to a lot of composition changes due to people switching jobs mid-term:
 - e.g. CZ.NIC, Comcast, Dyn, Afilias seats in past 2 years
- Consequences:
 - admin overhead of switching
 - lack of continuity within Board
- More common practice within industry is Board appointments belong to persons not organizations

Special Resolutions

- 1. "that Article IV of the Company's Bylaws shall be revised to provide that all of the Directors shall be elected by the members, and such change shall be effective beginning with the election of Directors at the Company's 2018 annual meeting of the members;"

 - Amendment to Bylaws requires super-majority of 3/4trs of Members present at quorate meeting, or 2/3rds of entire membership

Special Resolutions

- 2. "that all matters pertaining to the Members as set forth in the Company's Bylaws, including without limitation, voting rights, quorum calculations and other matters contained in Article III, shall pertain only to Members and shall not be applicable to Supporters."

 - Clarification of existing practice rather than actual change

Board Seats

- The Board seat for **Verisign**, held by **Duane Wessels** who has served for 2 years, is up for election by rotation.
- The Board seat for Oracle (previously Dyn), currently held by Liam Hynes, has been held for 2 years and is up for election by rotation.
- The Board seat for **Comcast**, currently held by **Peter Hagopian**, has been held for 2 years and is up for election by rotation.
- Ondřej Surý is stepping down due to a change in employment. As this seat has 1 year of term to run, CZ.NIC have appointed Jaromir Talir as his replacement.
 - **Ondřej Surý** is re-standing for election to one of the 3 available seats as a representative of his new employer, **ISC**.
- The elections for 2017 will be conducted under the current system of Board seats being held by Member organizations, not individuals, whether or not Special Resolution 1 is approved
