Goals of the Privacy Subcommittee

- Obtain informed and reliable opinions about the degree to which DNS-OARC currently satisfies the requirements of relevant privacy law for data
- Consider how to maximise the amount, usability and usage of data collected by OARC in future
- For different sources and types of datasets, the definition of metadata can simplify access to data
- Review privacy policies related to public services and work with an appropriate professional to develop and publish such a policy
- Propose a process for appointing a Privacy Officer

Finished Milestones

- Drafted charter for privacy committee
 - Received feedback from the OARC board
 - o To do: incorporate feedback and publish charter
- Conduct a survey with the OARC community on data sharing and usage
- Produce a short report for the OARC board
 - Current data storage (number of organisations, types of data shared, etc.)
 - Known data usage to date (how many accesses, usage of analysis resources, publications)

Next Key Milestones

- Report deficiencies in DNS-OARC's compliance with privacy law
 - Support from Beth Bacon (PIR) to identify issues and questions with primarily GDPR
 - o Involve a consultant (lawyer) to work with us to identify deficiencies and propose solutions
- Conduct surveys of the membership to inform decisions about direction
- Make recommendations to the DNS-OARC board
 - o changes that should be made in existing membership agreements
 - o infrastructure strategy with regards to data storage, access and use
