Voting

 - please note resolution voting is not anonymous, as per past practice at physical AGMs
 - resolution votes will be audited after the AGM
 - who voted how will not however be published
- Supporters and Members not currently in good standing may observe and interact, but do **not** have voting rights
- A Mattermost poll will appear after each resolution, and you will have 2 minutes to respond
 - please ensure you select FOR, AGAINST or ABSTAIN

- Voting is by Single Transferable Vote, rank candidates in descending order of preference
- You may vote for as few or as many as you wish
- Voting starts at 18:01 UTC on Thu 12th October ("tonight")
- Voting closes at 17:59 UTC on Fri 13th October

- The Board seat held by Paul Ebersman, who has served for 2 terms over four years, is up for election due to his stepping down, no longer being affiliated with an OARC Member.
- The Board seat held by Benno Overeinder, who has served 2 terms over four years, is up for election by rotation.

Board Candidate Selection

- The "Scottish" Single Transferable vote system will be used to select the winners
- The top three ranked candidates will receive 2-year terms
- The fourth-ranked candidate will receive a 1-year term
- In the event the initial election results in a 3rd / 4th place tie, the election will be re-run as a "count" using the existing cast votes to tie break
