OARC Membership?

- World's premier community of DNS technical experts
- Tools/services improving reliability, stability of DNS infrastructure
- Contribute and access s unique and growing DNS dataset
- Dedicated resources for coordinating response to incidents, outages and threats, as they happen (MM)
- Promote research into the DNS ecosystem





OARC Data sharing

- 750+ TB of data mix of DNS traces, DITL data, historical zone files, ...
- Researchers, vendors and operators can access unique datasets
- Ideal place to share data during/after incidents
 - Post mortems, unusual traffic patterns





Ongoing Projects

- Initiated the DITL data explorer project Verisign grant
- Ongoing migration of OARCs >750 TB data sets to CEPH
- New releases of OARC maintained tools (*dsc*, *dnsperf*, *dnscap*,..)
- Ongoing improvements to our Member Portal
- AS112 website automation and re-vamp ARIN Grant
- Solved IPv6 reachability issues for dnsviz (among others)





Participation

- OARC is an open forum
 - Attending events is open to everyone
 - Remote collaboration on public lists/forums
- Next level: OARC supporting Member
 - Participating in its governance
 - Accessing data shared by other members
 - Trusted environment responsible information sharing





Operational Best Practices
