2024-25 Plans

- Focus on cost reduction & seek additional funding sources where possible
- Data awareness and usefulness initiative
 - Improve quality of data archive (catalog and metadata), new DITL mgmt tools
 - Talk with Researchers about current analysis needs (and shortcomings)
 - See if the DITL Data Explorer (Crunchy) could interest more members
 - Recover remaining "cold" datasets to new Ceph Data Store
 - Privacy-centric, cloud-flexible re-structuring of Data Sharing Agreement
- Bring DNS BCPs discussion to OARC ('O'), and make OARC a voice in this space
- Continue outreach to members F2F interviews & possibly a survey
