 - please do not use this channel for discussions/questions etc
 - please note resolution voting during online and hybrid AGMs is **not** anonymous (as per past practice at physical AGMs)
 - resolution votes will be audited after the AGM
 - who voted how will not however be published
- You will need to be online and logged into Mattermost, even if you are present in-person!

- You will have 2 minutes to respond
- Please ensure you select FOR, AGAINST or ABSTAIN
