#### DNS-OARC Financials

- 2024 Financial Statements completed, clean bill of health
- \$28,000 deficit on \$641,000 revenue, as of 11 September 2025
- Gap between revenue and expenses has decreased significantly
- Revenue trending flat due to successful retention of membership revenue, and a few new members.
- Cash reserves currently at \$310,000 as of October 1, 2025





# 2025 Summary

- No fee increase considered for 2026 at this time
- \$29,000 deficit on \$641,000 revenue, as of 15 September 2025
- Current cash reserves are around \$310.000, with an expected slight increase by EOY, and expected to remain stable if income remains as it is.
- The goal to stabilize the financial situation has in large part been achieved
- Keeping costs in control is the priority, reducing them further would require looking at OARC's activities, and its mission.
- Next step is to work on identified opportunities to achieve an upwards trajectory and rebuild reserves.
